Scars & *Relics* is a film that traces these clues into the personal histories of three people, and their memories of childhood, childbirth, and of entering adulthood. These stories reveal the layers of experience behind the physical markings that are an intimate part of so many of us.

Ron McDougall studied Fine Arts at York University in Toronto, and works in graphic and interactive design. In 2001, he wrote and directed the short film *Breath*, which

screened at the 21st Atlantic Film Festival, and recently finished his second short film, *Lip Service*. In between, he produced the award-winning short film *Driven*. McDougall lives in Fall River, Nova Scotia.
